LODGING REGISTRATION FORM – ROUNDHOUSE 2020

Upon arrival please **register first** in the **Brotherhood Center (BCA)**. Sunday registration is **2:00-4:00, 7:30-7:55 & 9:00-11:00 p.m.** No check-in before 2:00 p.m. on Sunday. If your arrival is Sunday after hours or the next day, please call Cheryl so she knows when to expect you (417-349-2419). Specific room assignments are based on your selections. It is "first come, first serve" based upon receipt of the **registration forms and fee.**

(Saturday nights are available but at a special rate [see below], make plans directly with Cheryl by phone or email.)

SPECIAL NOTES: Those choosing to stay in the Williamson Lodge and Parkside Lodge will have a choice between 12 meals and 8 meals. Those who stay in the RV/Tent area may choose between 12, 8, or 4 meals. Children under 6 are not charged for any lodging or meals. ALL bunks are Twin XL size. If you choose to rent a room for Saturday night it is a flat fee of \$99.00, no meals will be furnished. There are NO COOKING facilities except for those residing in the RV/Campground area. Please contact Cheryl for any special dietary needs.

Williamson Lodge 1: Motel accommodations, sheets and towels furnished. Two floor levels, no elevator. Heat and air in all rooms. Two double beds and one set bunks. Private bath. Sleeps 6. Park at door of first level. If your family size is over 6 and the youngest is not an infant in a playpen, you will be assigned a connecting room (no extra charge). We will not assign rooms on the second floor unless absolutely necessary.

Williamson Lodge 2: Motel accommodations, sheets and towels furnished. Three floor levels, no elevator. Heat and air in all rooms. One queen-size bed and two sets bunks, private bath. Sleeps 6. If your family size is over 6 and the youngest is not an infant in a playpen, you will be assigned a connecting room (no extra charge). The lowest level is called the Garden level, (the 400 series) they are partially below ground level. Entrance is either by a half-flight of stairs down or a ramp. Rooms are accessed from an inner hallway. These rooms have a bit more "moving around" space, as a result this is where LWCC staff recommends we fill first. We will not assign rooms on the 2 upper floors unless absolutely necessary. There are 4 ADA compliant rooms in this building on the Garden Level accessible by ramp. Simply indicate on your lodging if an ADA room is required.

Parkside Lodge: Dorm rooms. Heat and air in all rooms. This building is not close to other lodging areas but is near the playground. One Full-size bed and three sets of bunk beds sleeps 8. Private bath. Park at door. No linens, no bedspreads, no towels.

RV and Tent camping: There are 200 sites. All sites have water and electric. NO SEWER hook-up. We have negotiated use of the Activity Center shower/bathhouse to accommodate those in the campground (We've chosen not to use the bathhouse down by the swimming pool). As a result, we ask that you choose sites between the numbers 113 through 181. We will not assign you a site, you will be allowed to choose within that range. This should allow for you to space yourselves a bit.
